The Department of Anesthesiology, a comprehensive anesthesiology service, is staffed with generalists and specialty experts who care for patients during procedures ranging from complicated pediatric to cardiac, neurosurgery and organ transplantation. The department works closely with all clinical departments to provide the full spectrum of anesthesia care and consultation to patients of all ages. The department also provides medical direction for the Post-Anesthesia Care Unit and for the Respiratory Care Department.

Research interests are maintained in such areas as anesthesia-related technology, neuro-transmitters and CNS function, respiratory physiology, cardiac anesthesia, and ischemia-reperfusion injury.
